**CELEBRATING THE LIFE AND LEGACY OF
REV. DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.
(1929-1968)**

WHEREAS, on January 20, 2020 our Nation honors the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, American clergyman and Nobel Prize winner, a man committed to the principles of freedom, opportunity and equal justice for all; and

WHEREAS, Dr. King devoted his life to justice and equality for people of all races and economic standings through non-violent means, which led to the establishment of many Federal and local laws prohibiting discrimination and fostering human rights; and

WHEREAS, in August 1963, Dr. King delivered his stirring "I Have A Dream" address on the steps of the Lincoln Memorial, a speech creating the momentum that resulted in the Civil Rights Act of 1964 which prohibited segregation in public accommodations, as well as discrimination in education and employment; and

WHEREAS, Dr. King once said, "Life's most persistent and urgent question is: What are you doing for others?" leading communities across the country to answer that question by coming together to honor Dr. King by helping their neighbors and communities through thousands of service projects spread across all fifty states; and

WHEREAS, as a result of Dr. King's leadership and highly visible moral stance, he was awarded the 1964 Nobel Prize for Peace; and

WHEREAS, on April 4, 1968, Dr. King was felled by an assassin's bullet before he could finish his important work; and

WHEREAS, Dr. King's legacy lives in the vision and life of all Americans.

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer of Somerset County has certified in writing the availability of funds for the purposes set forth in this Resolution, such certification on file with the Deputy Clerk of the Board, and such funds are provided for in the duly adopted temporary budget of the County of Somerset, line item (01-201-27-018-699-201) \$6,277.02; and

WHEREAS, Somerset County Department Health requires a medical/clinical health care services contract to furnish services of skilled qualified and licensed personnel to perform all supervision and services necessary for Reproductive Health Care, Cancer Screening and Primary Health Care services to the Under-insured and Medically Underserved Population for Bedminster Township, Far Hill Borough, Franklin Township, Manville Borough, North Plainfield Borough, Raritan Borough, and Somerville Borough; and

WHEREAS, one (1) sealed proposal was received and read for Health Care Providers to Furnish Services for Reproductive Health Care, Cancer Screening and Primary Health Care for Under-Insured and Medically Underserved Population – Contract #: CY-COM-0018-18 on November 21, 2017 at 2:30 PM prevailing time; and

WHEREAS, the Evaluation Team included representatives from the Somerset County Health Office has determined that the proposal as submitted by Zufall Health Center, 71 Fourth Street, Somerville, NJ 08876 met the necessary requirements of the County specifications during the first two years of the contract; and
