Vote By Mail Ballots

The Somerset County Board of Elections will be in session on June 2, 2020 at 8:00 a.m. to review Vote by Mail Ballots at the Board offices located at 20 Grove Street, Somerville, New Jersey. The Board will consider any Challenges submitted to a Vote by Mail Ballot at that time.

All Vote by Mail Ballots postmarked on or before June 2, 2020 and received within 48 hours of this date will be tallied on June 8, 2020 at 10:00 a.m.

If any official Challenger (who is a designated Challenger for the Board of Elections offices for the June 2, 2020 Primary Election) wishes to Challenge any Vote by Mail Ballot, they must do so not later than 3:00 p.m. on May 29, 2020. Any Vote by Mail Ballots received by the Board after that time will be subject to Challenge until 3:00 p.m. on June 1, 2020.

Please call the Board of Elections to notify of your intent to Challenge and to schedule a time to review the Vote by Mail Ballots of interest.

Please bring any supporting documentation and be prepared to complete an Affidavit for each Challenge submitted.

Note: It is the sole responsibility of the Commissioners of the Board of Elections to review signatures. Any 2-2 tie among the Commissioners must be forwarded to a Superior Court Judge to break such tie.
