

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING LIMITS ALONG NEW CENTRE ROAD, COUNTY ROUTE 627, IN THE TOWNSHIP OF HILLSBOROUGH, COUNTY OF SOMERSET

Somerset that; BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of

SECTION 1. Speed Limits for both directions of traffic along New Centre Road, County Route 627, in the Township of Hillsborough, County of Somerset be established as follows;

ZONE 1. 45 MPH from South Branch Road, County Route 625 to a point approximately 1750 feet north of Auten Road.

ZONE 2. 35 MPH from a point approximately 1750 feet north of Auten Road, to a point approximately 3,360 feet north of Auten Road.

ZONE 3. 45 MPH from a point approximately 3,360 feet north of Auten Road, to Roycefield Road.

SECTION 2. Regulatory and Warning signs, conforming to the current Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways, shall be erected and maintained to effect the above designed speed limit.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication as required by law and upon certification by the Somerset County Engineer.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all previous ordinances or resolutions establishing speed limits on the aforementioned roadway(s) or portions of the roadway(s) herein described are hereby repealed.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the foregoing Ordinance was duly introduced and passed on first reading at a regular meeting of the Board of Chosen Freeholders, Somerset County, State of New Jersey, held on February 14, 2017.
