STAGE 2A TRAFFIC PATTERN CHANGE NOTICE

DATE: July 15, 2019

TO: RESIDENTS NEAR WASHINGTON VALLEY ROAD RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

On or about July 22nd traffic patterns for the Washington Valley Road Reconstruction Project will change and work will start in the area to the west of Van Nest Drive (Stage 2A). Stage 2A Traffic Pattern will last until approximately early September. Residents within the Stage 2A and 2B work-zones will receive updates regarding work progress as well as information regarding any changes to the location of the barricades.

On or about July 22nd, the full barricade that is currently at Van Nest Drive will be moved approximately 800 feet west near a culvert adjacent to #2025 Washington Valley Road. A map showing the revised access plan is enclosed.

Residents along Van Nest Drive, Lynne Way, Wilde Hollow Road and Washington Valley Road house numbers 2032 to 2055 will access their properties from the east and not from Chimney Rock Road as was done previously.

Properties from 1979 to 2025 Washington Valley Road will continue to have access from the west via the intersection of Chimney Rock Road.
