HOW IS IT SPREAD?

BY AN INFECTED PERSON:

- Within 6 feet of you.
- That coughs or sneezes near you.

FROM SURFACES:

- Touching an object that has the virus on it, then touching your face



PLAN AHEAD:

- Have an emergency plan in case children can't go to school or you can't go to work.
- Talk to your employer about alternative work arrangements.

WASH HANDS OFTEN WITH SOAP & WATER, AT LEAST 20 SECONDS



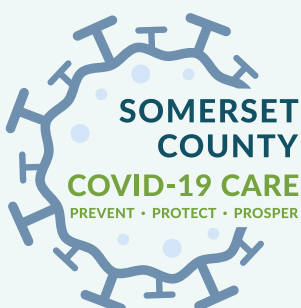
COVER YOUR COUGHS AND SNEEZES WITH A TISSUE OR THE INSIDE OF YOUR ELBOW
